

## DROP STITCH SCARF

You will need: Size 13 or 15 , 10” needles.  
Use one or two yarns together.

1. Cast on an odd amount of stitches.
2. 1<sup>st</sup> row: Knit 1, yarn over and knit until end of row.
3. 2<sup>nd</sup> row: Knit 1 slip 1 until the last stitch. Knit last stitch.
4. Continue pattern of two rows until desired length.

This is the Christmas gift scarf because it is fast and can be made with less yarn than normal. The pattern allows the yarn to go farther. If you choose a two yarn combination, it adds a certain glamour to it that is perfect for a gift. Make this one for someone special in your life, or... for yourself!

## SEED STITCH SCARF

You will need: Size 9, 10, or 11 , 10” needles.  
Use appropriate gage yarn with needles. Thin yarn with thin needles, so that you can see the beautiful pattern of the seed.

1. Cast on an odd amount of stitches.
2. 1<sup>st</sup> Row: Knit, Purl alternating until end of row.
3. 2<sup>nd</sup> row and continuing rows: Repeat pattern.
4. Cast off at desired length.

The seed stitch is a sophisticated stitch that you will use over and over. It looks very professional on things like a blanket border. By casting on an odd amount of stitches for a seed stitch scarf, every time you turn your work, you will begin with a knit.
